(17th and 18th of July 2026)

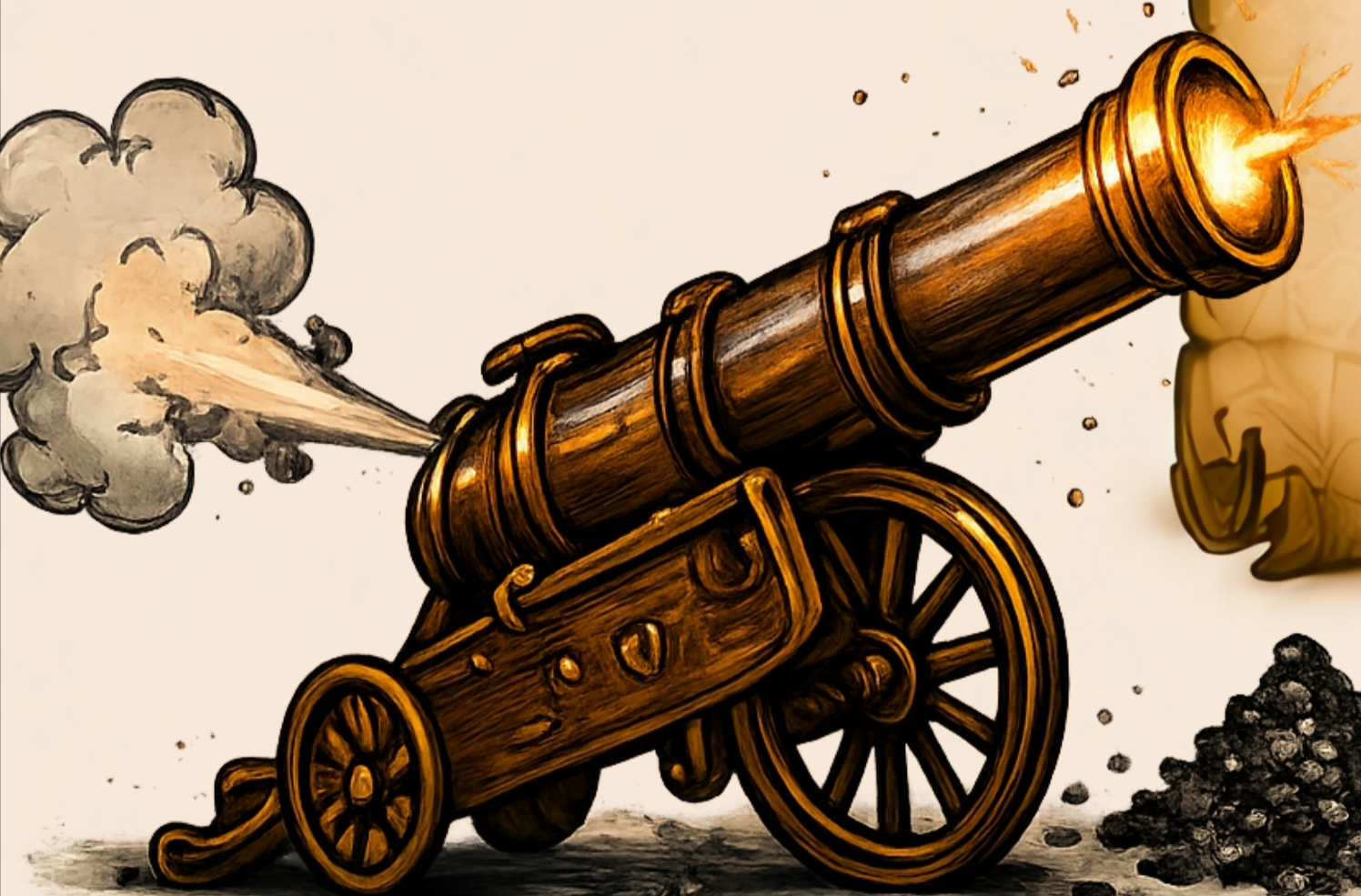
The smell and force of gunpowder.

through the streets of the town. But it
is especially spectacular during the
disembarkment at dawn on Saturday.

It is the sound of muskets and the
smell of gunpowder. **Have you ever
heard the blast of a musket? Or
smelled gunpowder burning?** Before
the sun rises, Moorish ships can
already be seen approaching, ready to
set foot on the sands of Mitja Galta Beach.

There, the Christian side awaits them at
their castle by the shoreline, with their
troops encamped on the sand.
A long and fierce battle follows. Words
will do little. Conflict becomes inevitable.

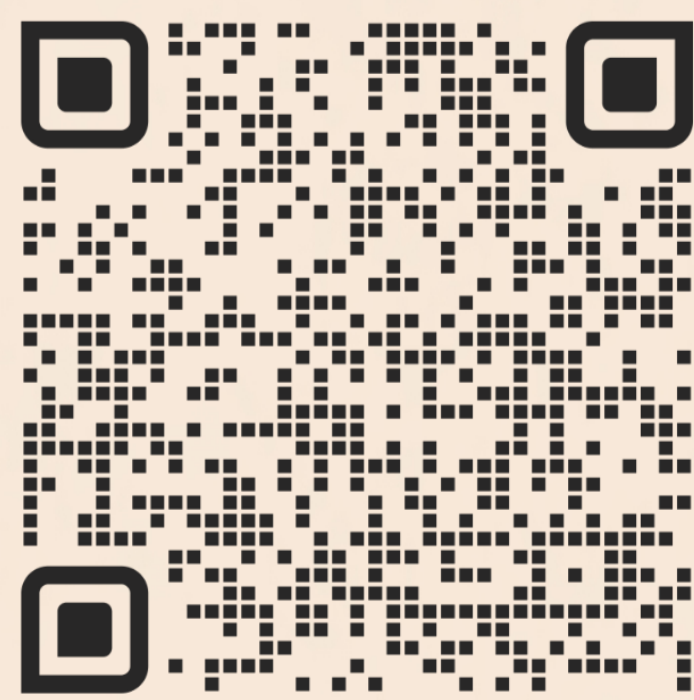
Swords against scimitars, Christian
